NHS Organ Donor Register

The NHS Organ Donor Register records the details of people who have registered their wishes to be an organ and/or tissue donor after their death.

This confidential information is used by authorised medical staff to establish whether a person wanted to donate.

Anyone can register. Age isn't a barrier to becoming an organ or tissue donor – people in their 70s and 80s have become donors and saved many lives. Most medical conditions don't rule you out either.

One donor can save or transform up to nine lives. It's only through the generosity of people like you that lives can be saved.
