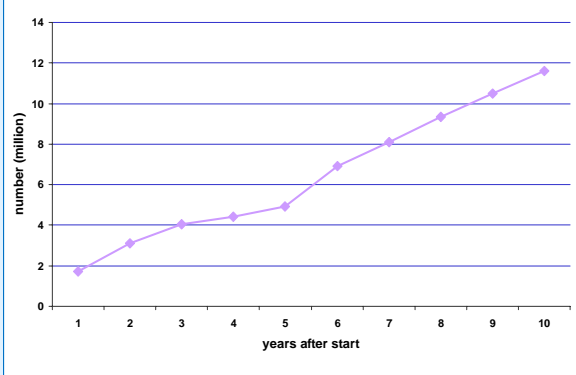

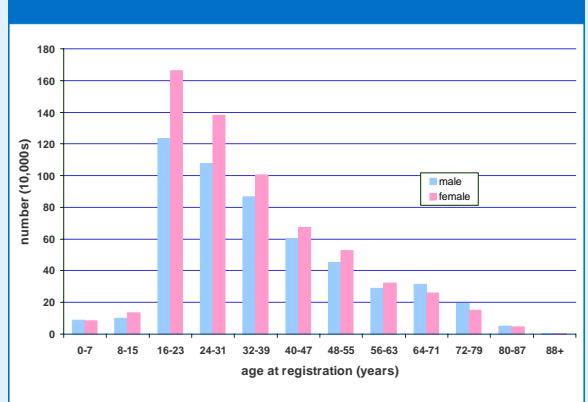

Total number registered on the ODR each year after the start



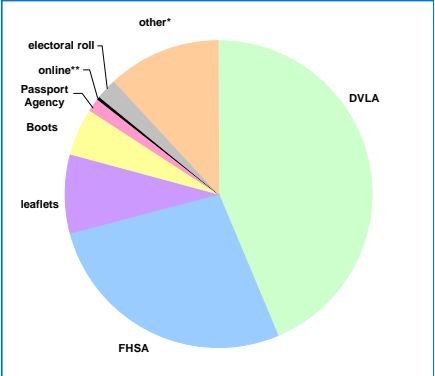
- 11.6 million after 10 years

Route through which registrants join the ODR



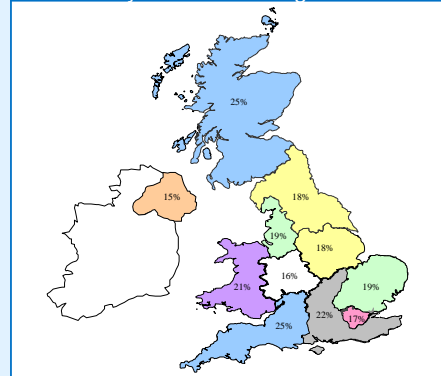

ODR – background and use

- Register of people wishing to donate organs on their death (including which organs)
- Established in October 1994
- Complemented by the Donor Card
- Accessible by coordinators etc – eases donation process
- Useful for raising awareness of donation
- Useful for directing and evaluating campaigns
- 23% of actual donors were registered on the ODR

Proportion of population registered on the ODR by former NHS region



- Scotland and South-west are 'kindest'
- 19.7% for all UK

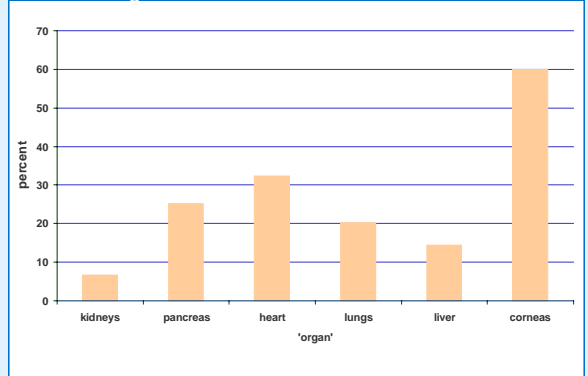
Ethnicity of registrants on the ODR compared with the UK population



Note: Ethnic origin is only recorded for 4% of the ODR registrants.

- ethnic minorities are under-represented on the ODR

- * 88% indicated no restrictions
- corneas specified most often for non-donation
